

Testing Web UI 12-05-10

Using howe, Parallels - Win 7 - IE 9 Developer Tools on, user gus, data imported by EH 12-05-09

Latest build ?12-05-09.

Start 0845 hrs

Data manager tree shows new data as imported by EH
Created new project and new dataset
Copied image from old dataset pasted into new - not immediately visible
Opened existing image in image viewer - the one I had copied
Zoom OK

Crash - not error message/console feedback

Delay loading when changing to high resolution view - given "loading ... " message
No image visible
Left for 2 minutes - no image yet
When try to go back to data manager had been logged out
No error message - no crash message
? timeout

Tried to log back in - failed

Tried to log in again - succeeded

Repeated zoom and switch to higher resolution
Worked as expected - 1-2 second "Loading ..." message only

? if previous problem was because the image was being copied.
Tried to replicate with another image - no problems - all functionality as expected

Workflow Issue

If you copy image link and paste into another browser - have to log in and then go to image, image appears in image viewer (full page) but no access to main data manager window - is this expected behaviour? should it maybe be flagged to have

this appear in pop-up with DM window behind - sort of leaves you stuck with nowhere to go. ? maybe this is desirable - debate!

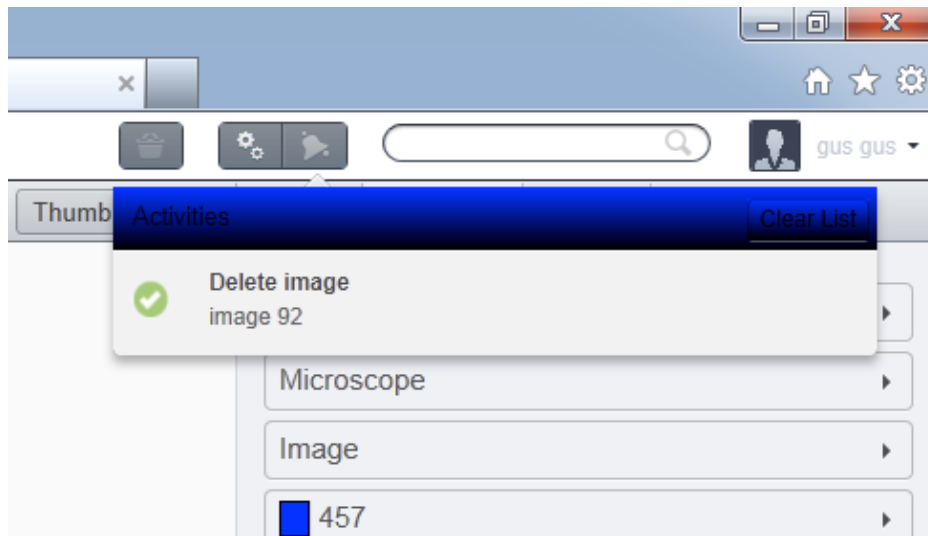
CSS Bug

Activity drop down - plain bright blue header BG makes it very difficult to see title and button - in fact I though they were missing and only saw them on zoomed screenshot. (Whereas in Mac Safari stand out well against grey BG. See screenshots below.

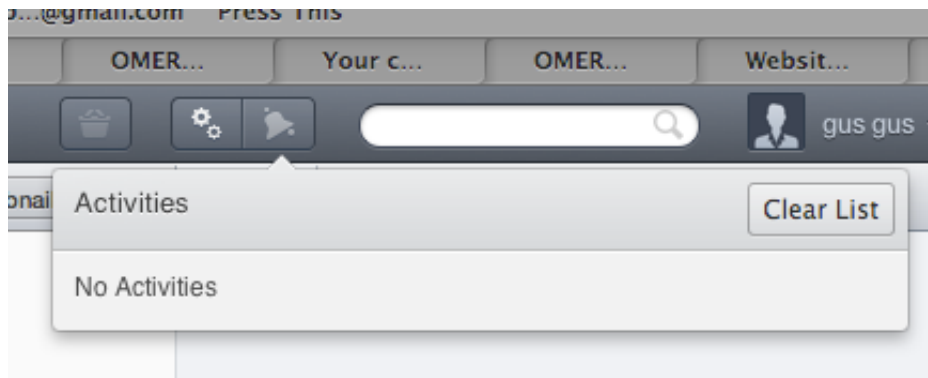

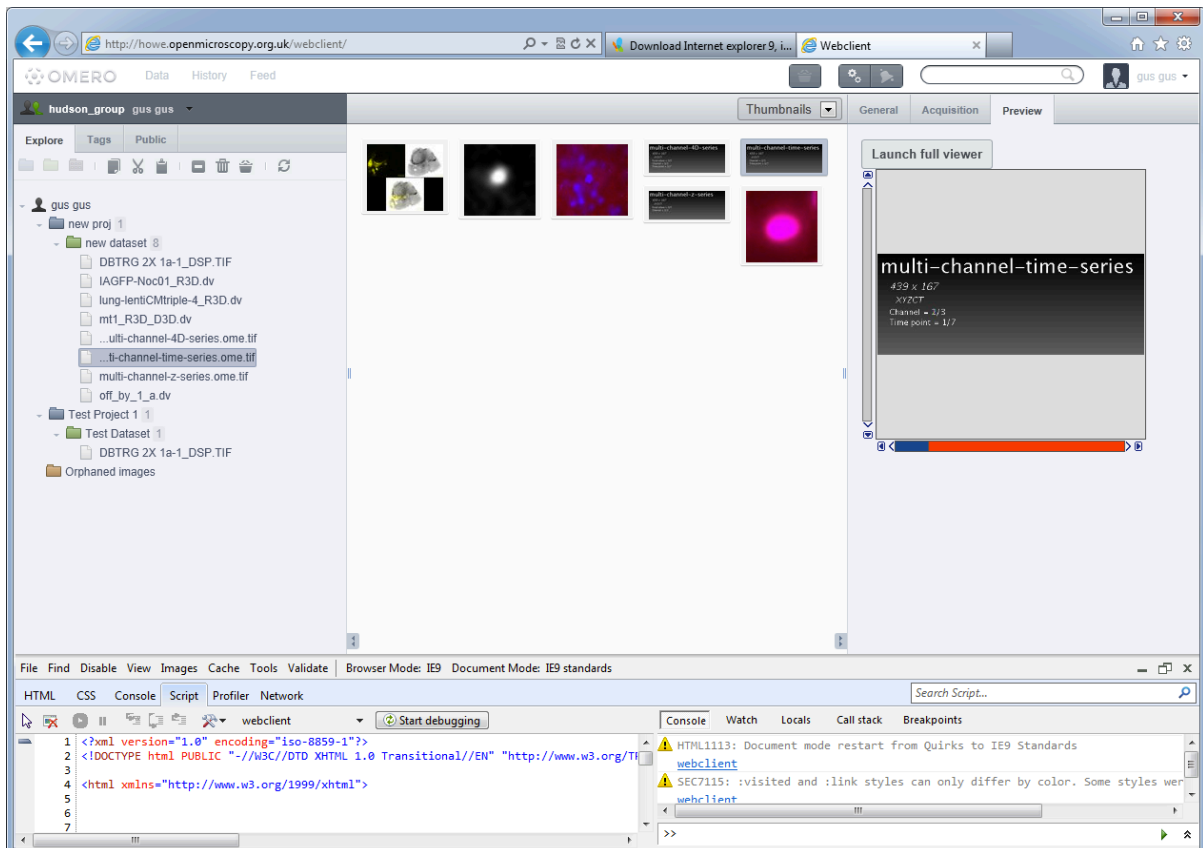
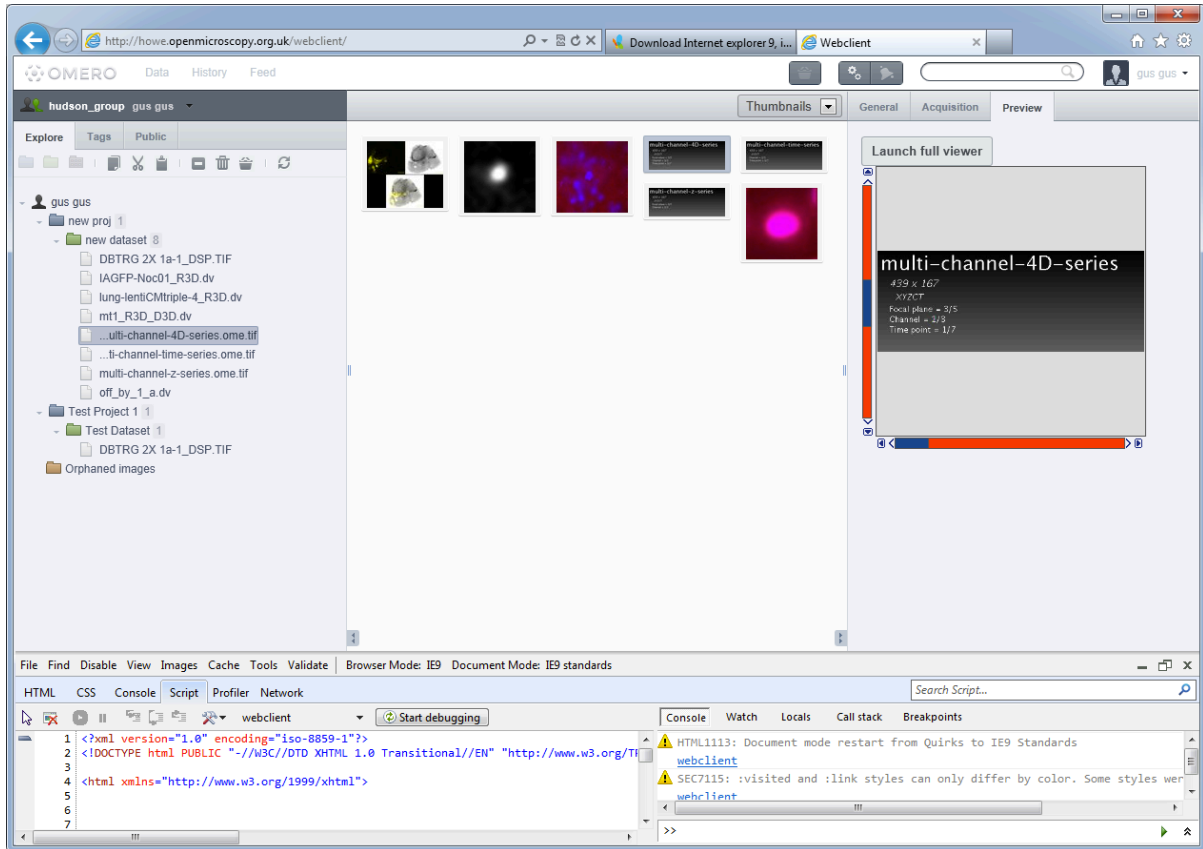


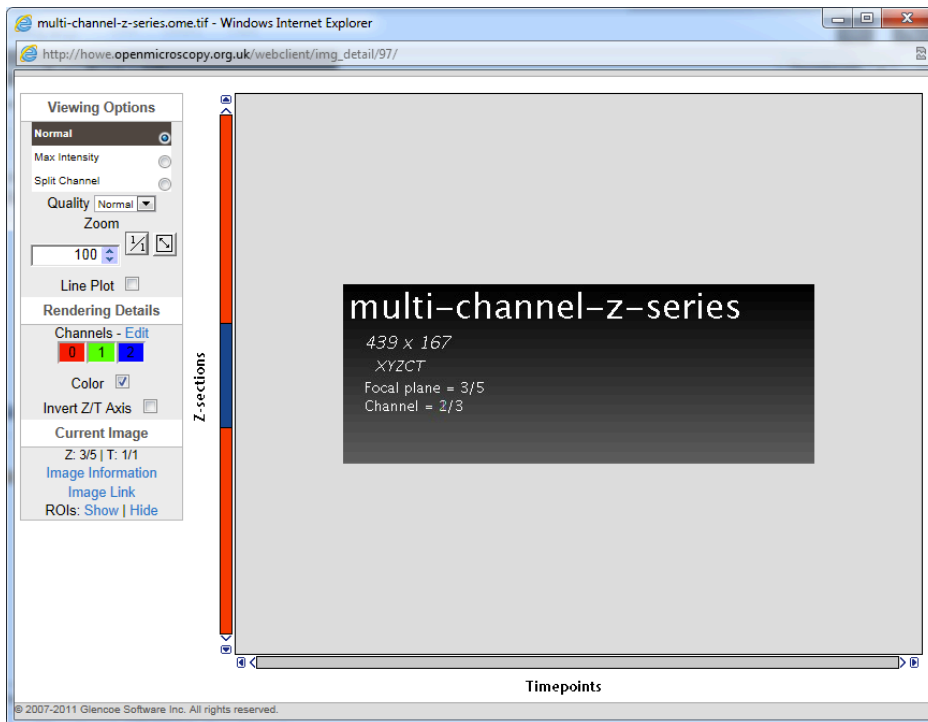
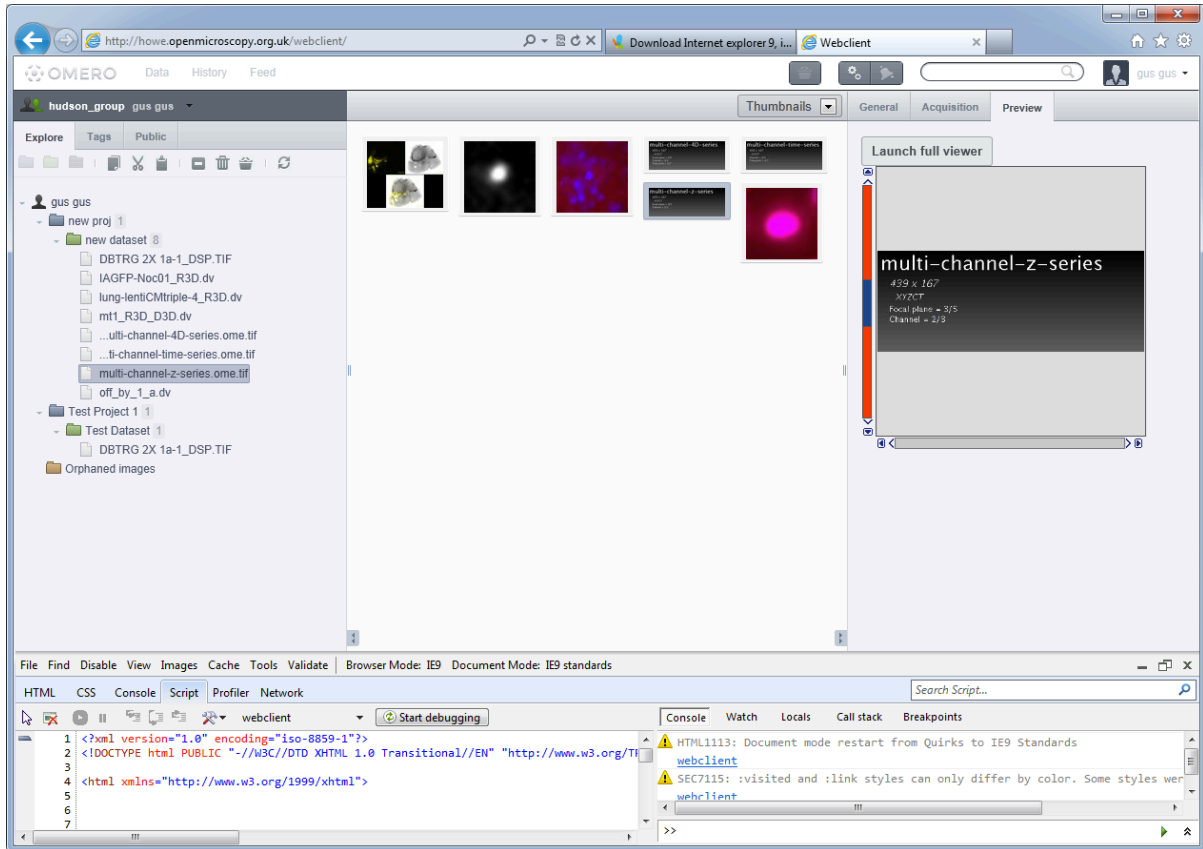


Query?

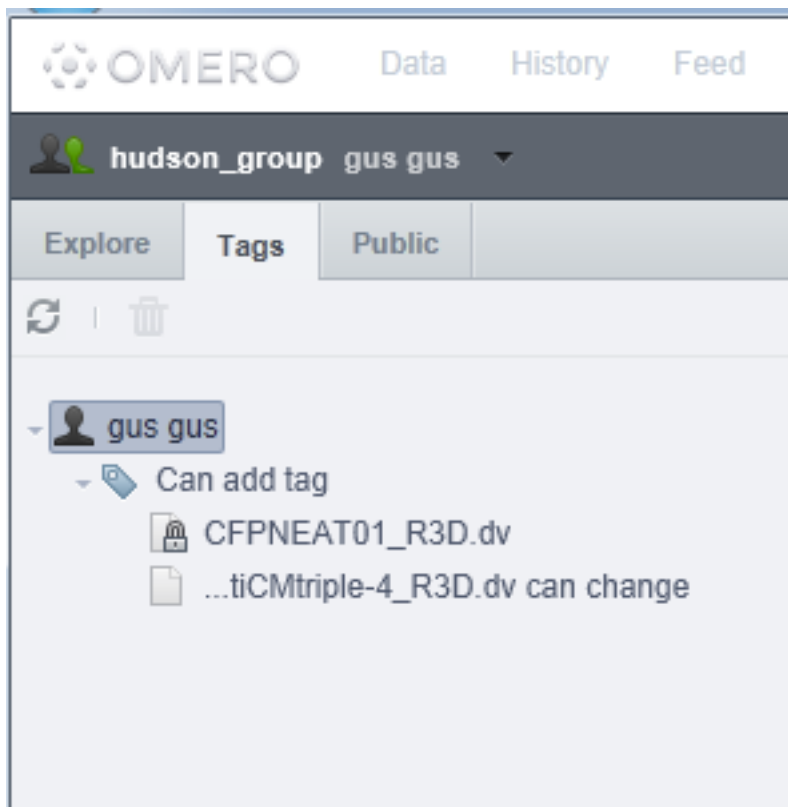
Tried to click on image again - same crash message

No error message when server taken down while logged in - in IE Console or anywhere else!

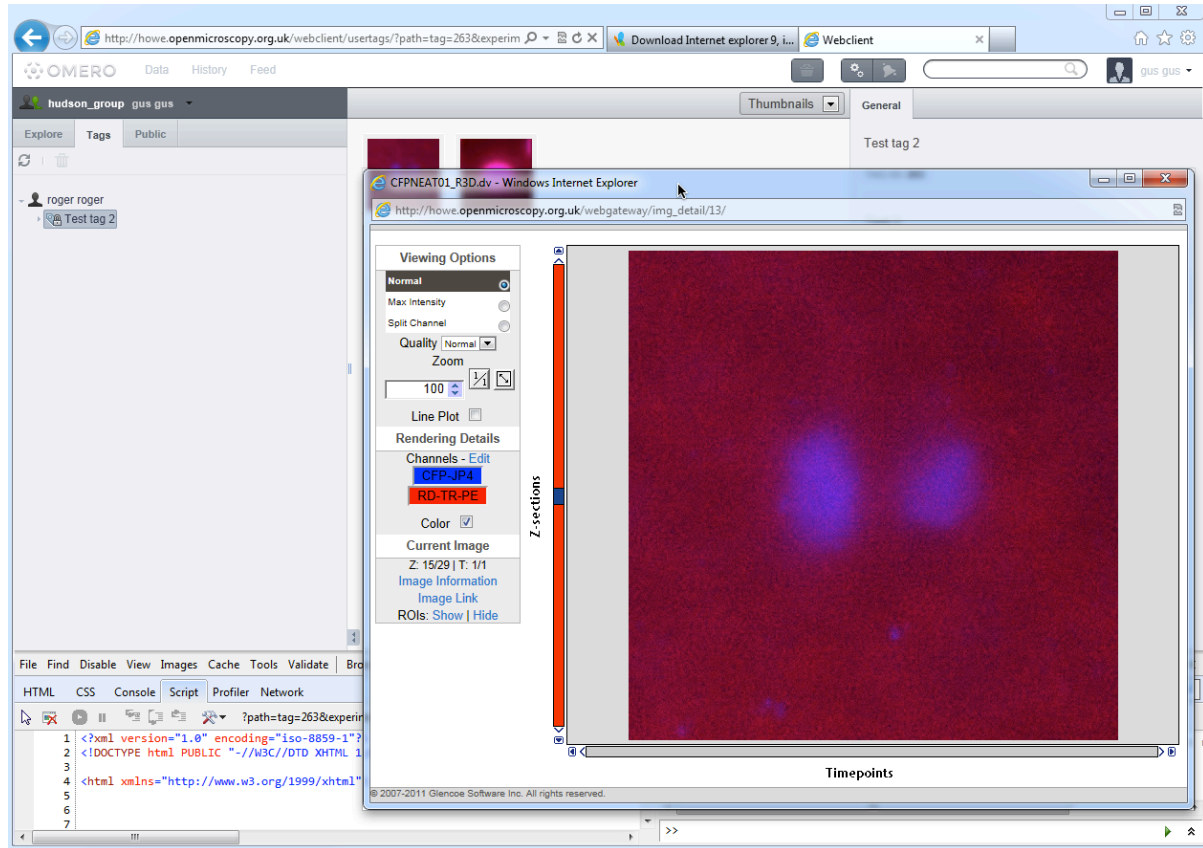
Workflow/Permissions/Accessing other users data Issue

Looked at my "Tags" tab and saw a "locked" tag that was clearly not mine as I do not have that image in my data.

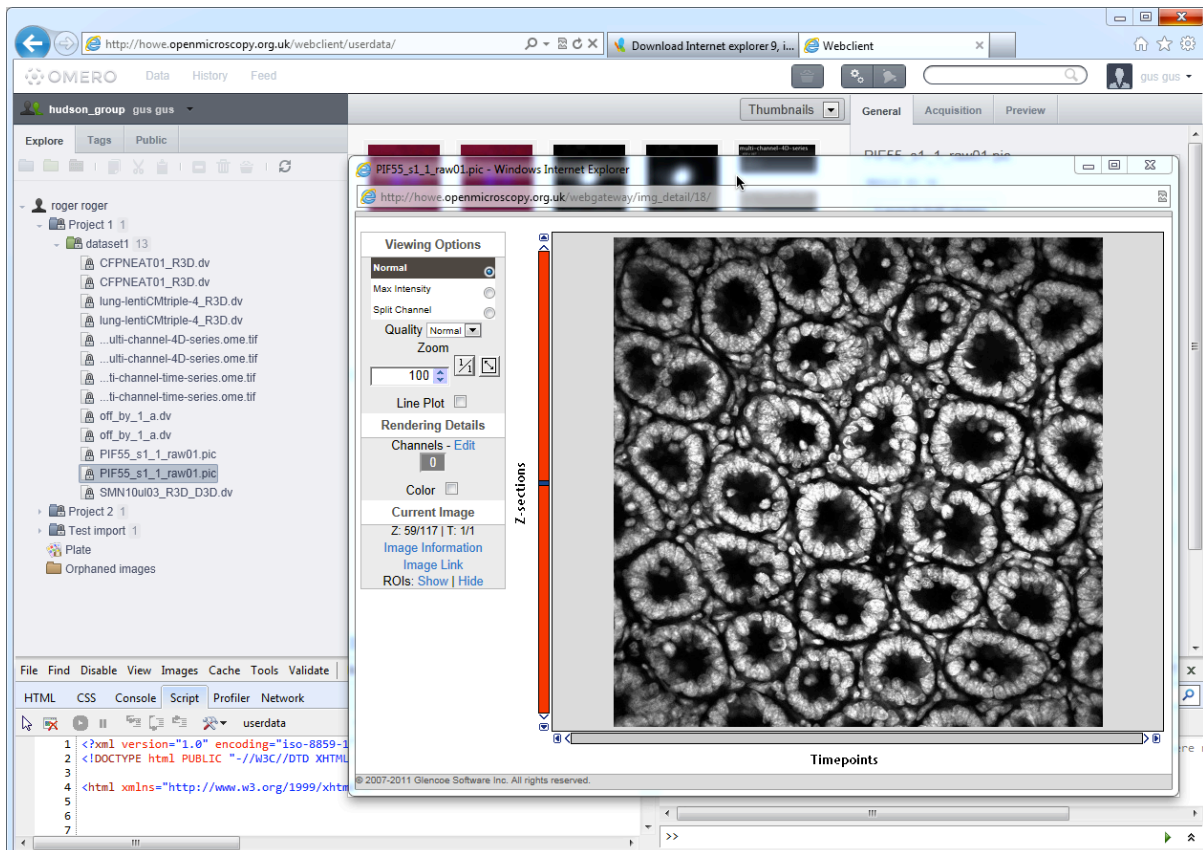


By clicking on this tag in the right hand pane, I get roger's tags in the left hand pane.

By then clicking “Explore” I can navigate through to the owner’s data and view the image.



From there if I then click on the “Explore” tab I end up in Roger’s data tree - and I can help myself and view anything I like. I can add tags and attachments and comment but not edit name or description.



Issue with Account Settings Workflow

No cancel/close button on "Account Settings" dialog - only save

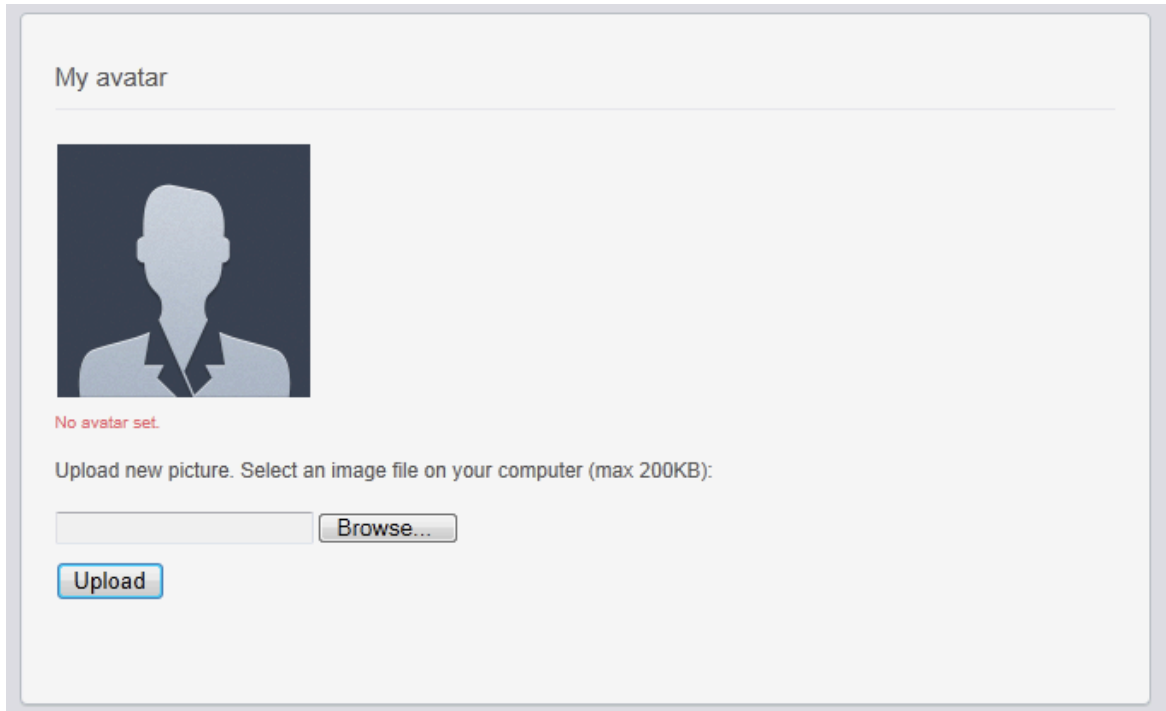

Noticed on logging out and back in again that the login button has now gone dark blue as well.



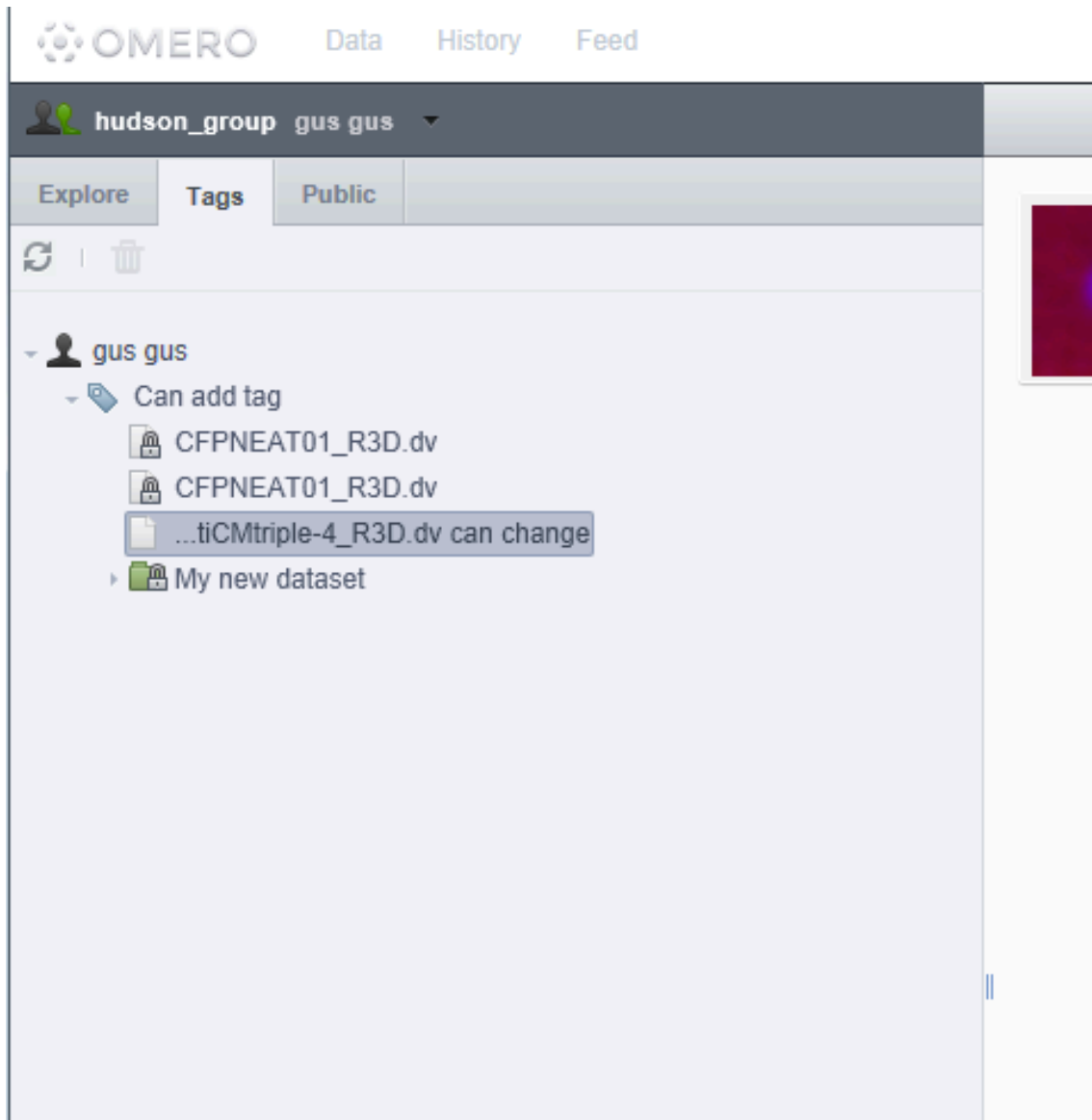
Attempt to login failed

Left hand pane - file names being truncated even when pane size is increased - both "Explore" and Tags. ? point of having expanding pane.

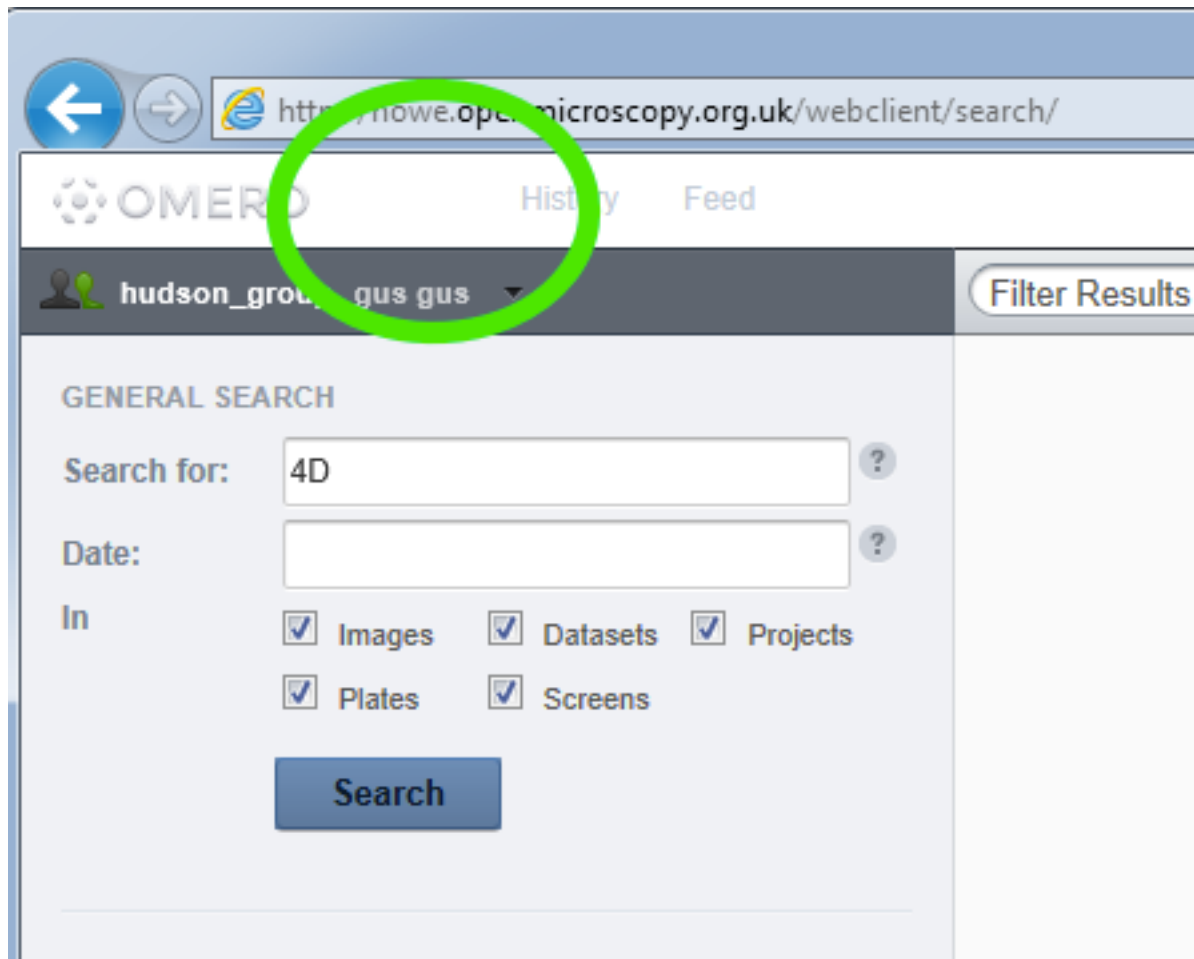

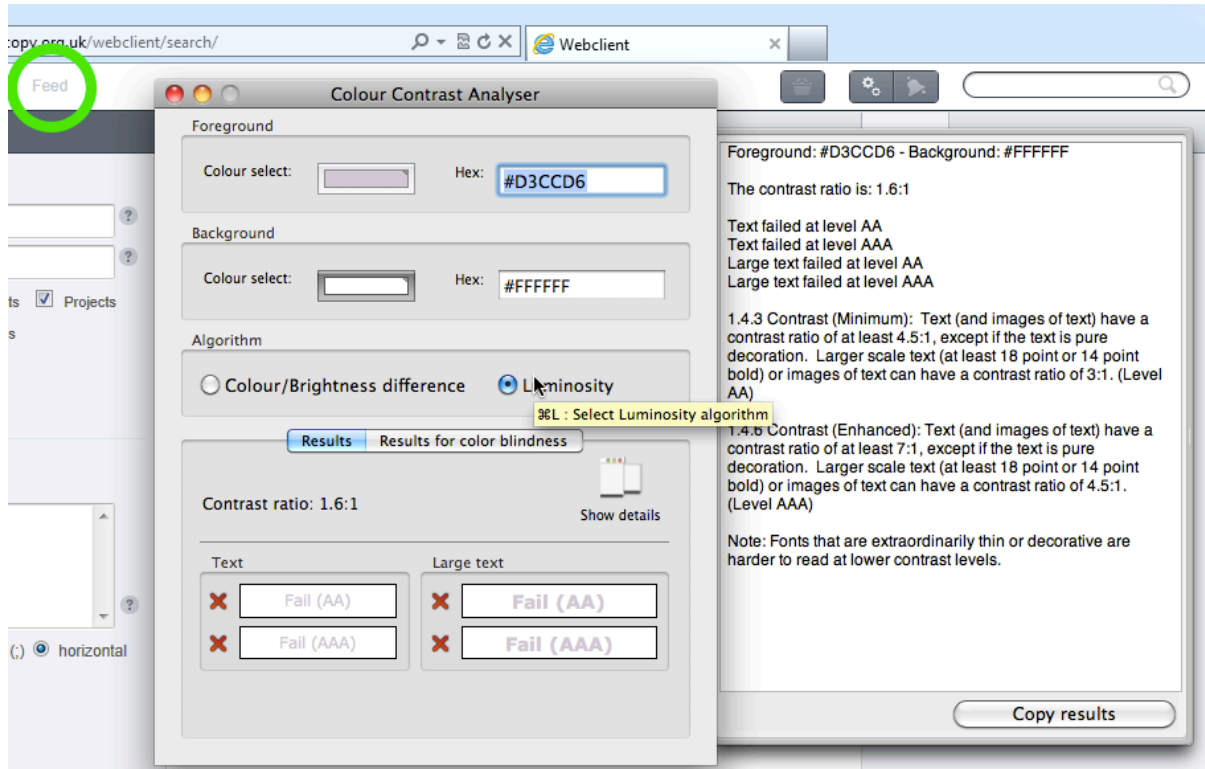


Issue with Contrast

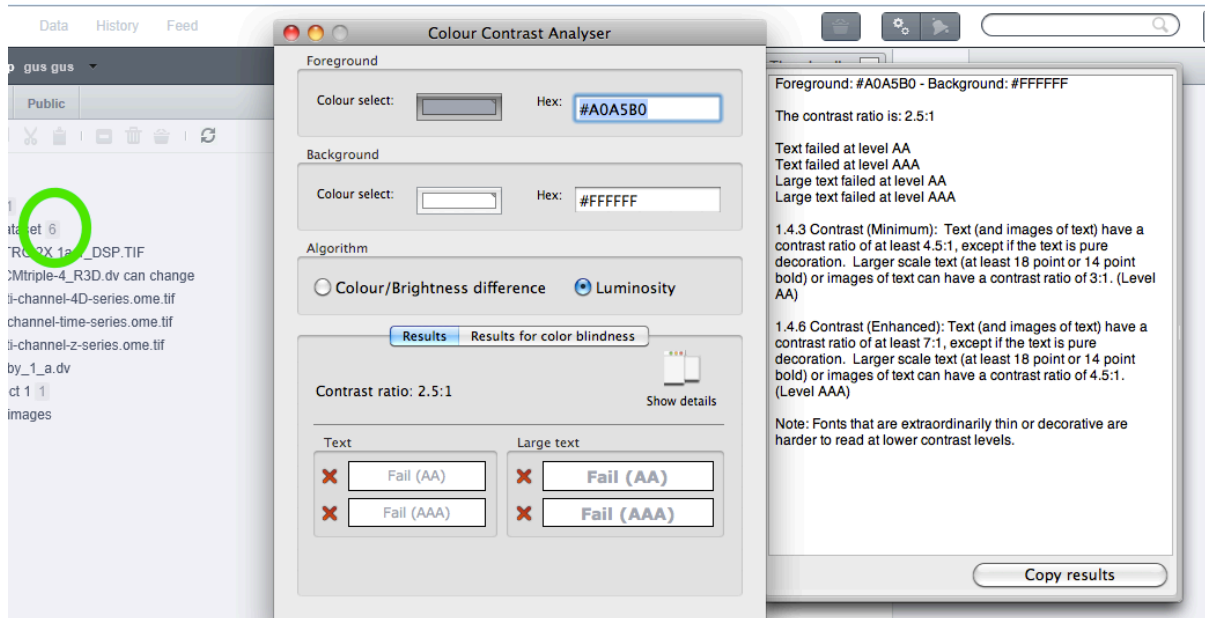
The lightening of toolbar item text on mouseover makes it disappear completely.



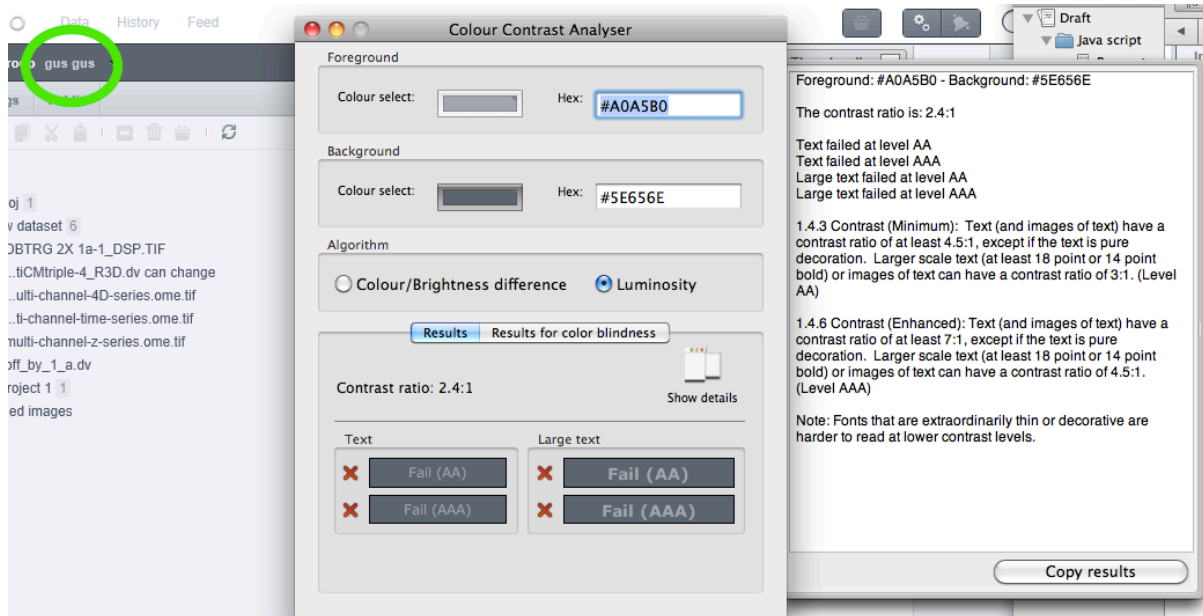
Contrast for toolbar text fails WCAG guidelines for contrast completely - 1.6:1 - (minimum 4.5:1):



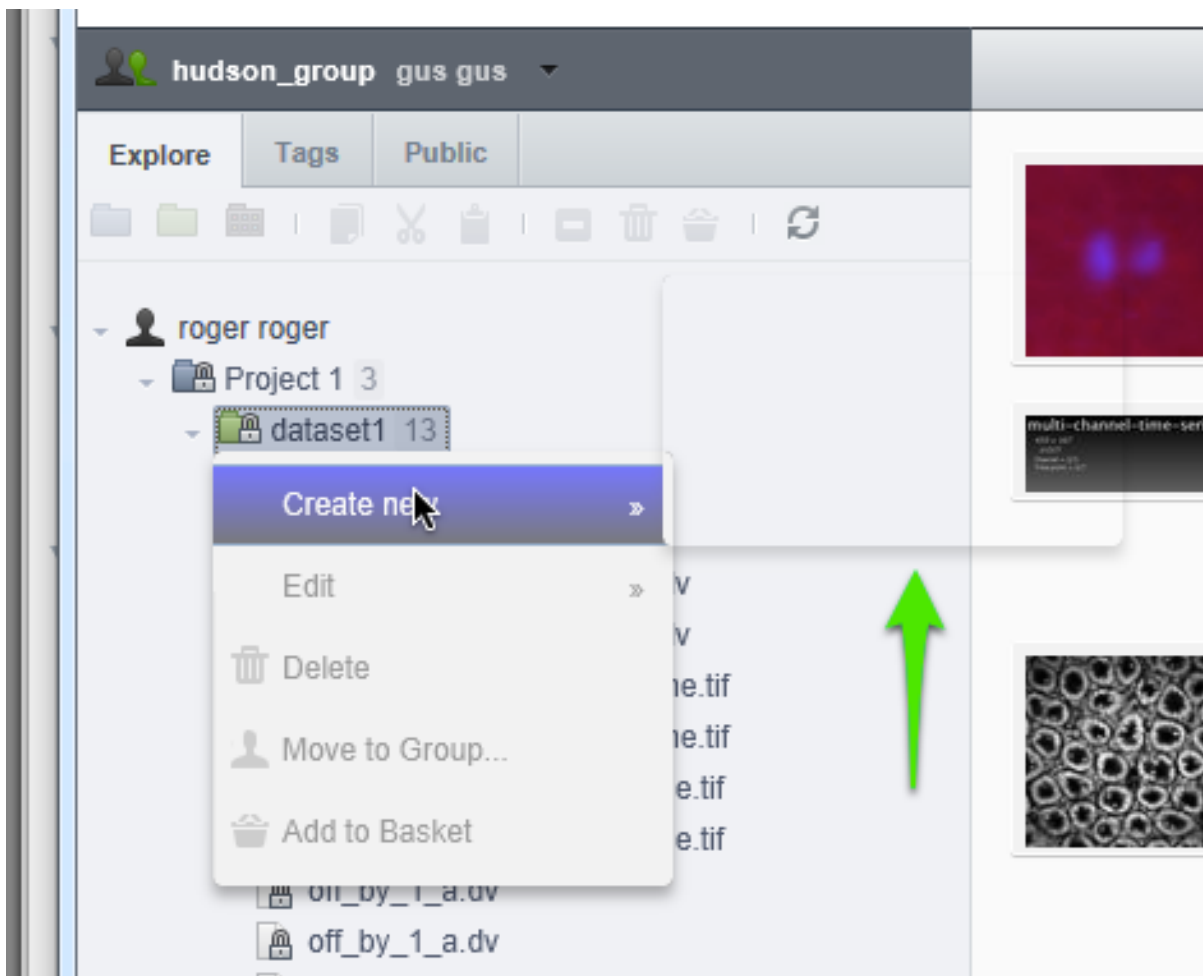
Contrast for the numbers indicating items in a dataset/project also fails WCAG - 2.5:1 - (minimum 4.5:1):



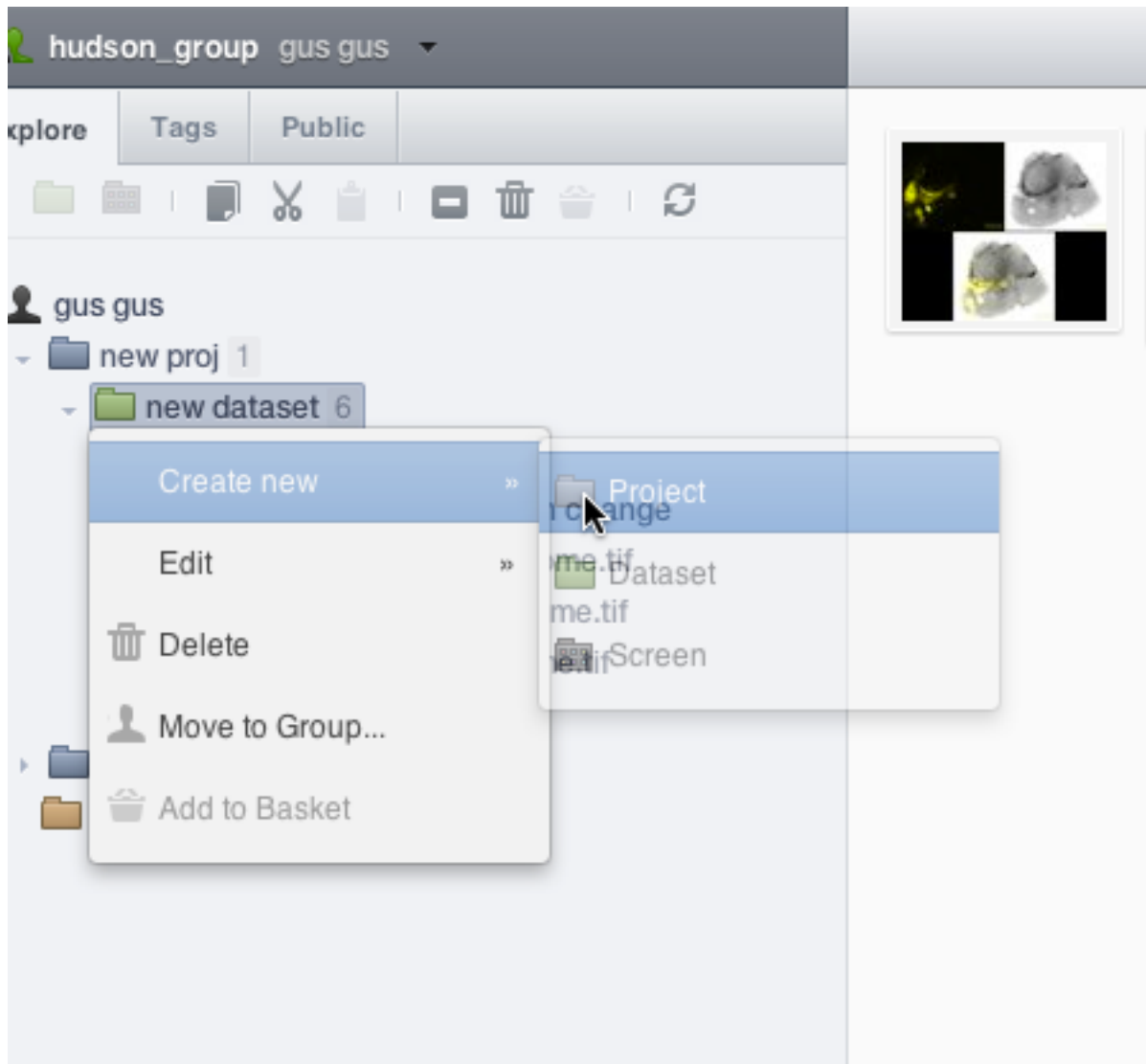
Contrast for toolbar text fails AA level of WCAG guidelines for contrast completely - 2.4:1 - (minimum 4.5:1):



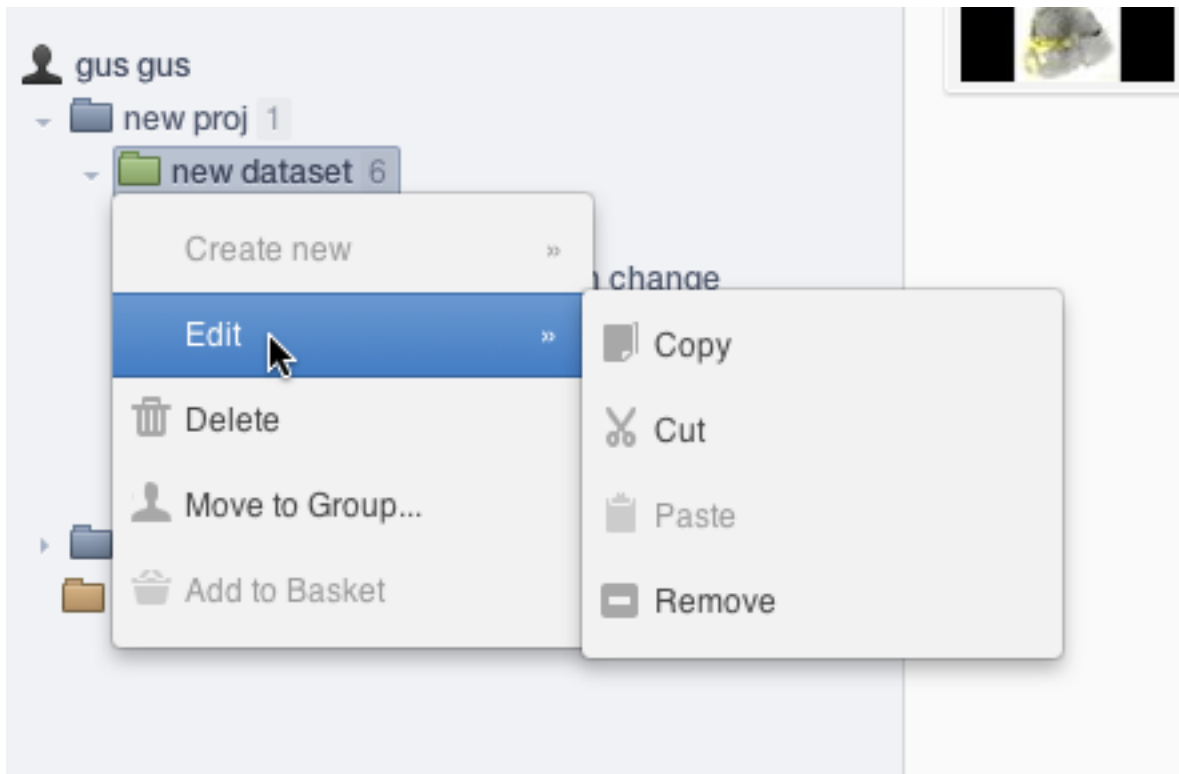
Bug: Ghost sub-menus with disabled items (greyed out)



Also happening in Safari on Mac with active menus (not greyed out)



Intermittent - sometimes menus are not affected - no pattern found



Strange menu behaviour

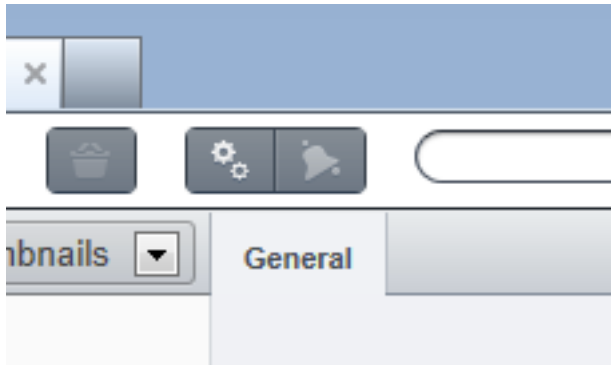
Drop-down menus seem to disappear far too easily even when mouse is definitely down and cursor definitely in the middle of the menu.

It looks as if it may be when transitioning from one menu item to another the focus on the menu is lost, as it is also occurring when doing from primary to secondary item in the hierarchy.

Wonder if it is just IE9?
Does not happen with Safari on the Mac

Still got bell icon for activities



Lock flag/icon on other users's data
